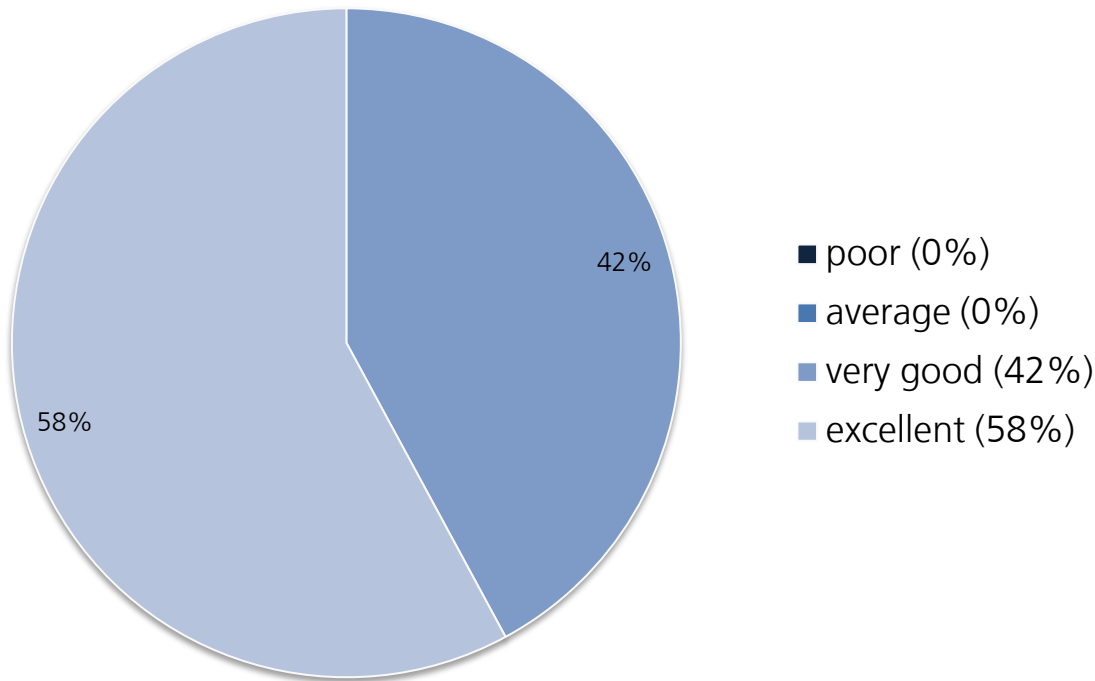


Overview

- Unanimous feedback that such a Summer School should be offered again

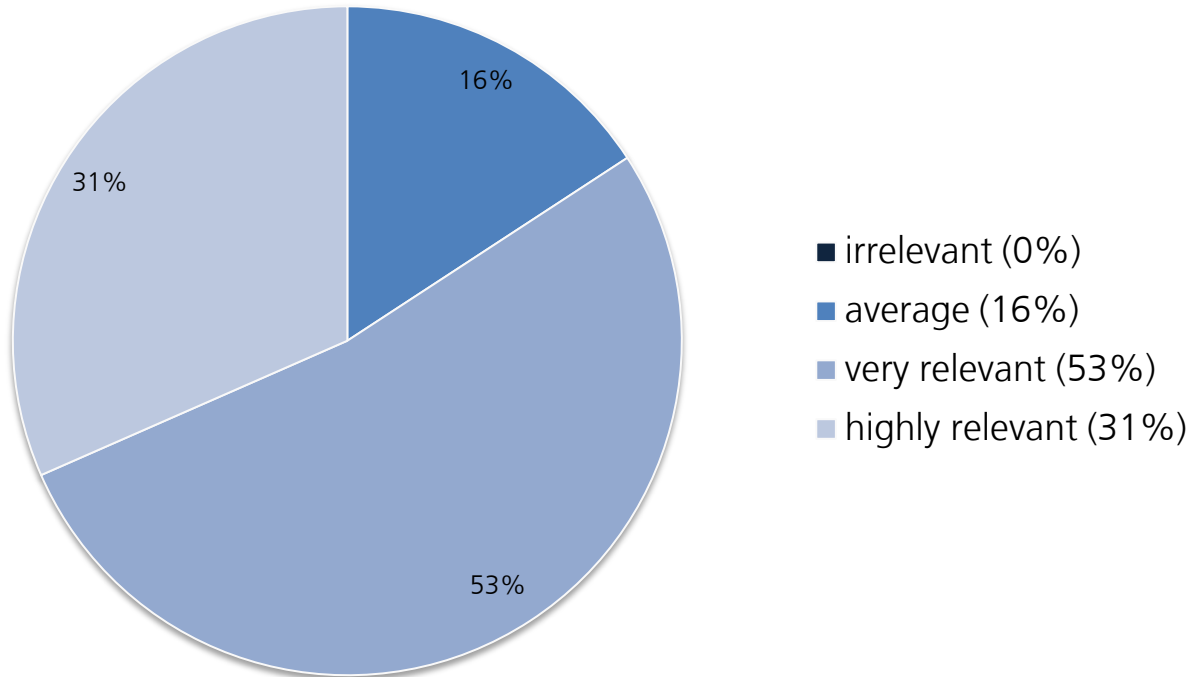


1. How would you rate the HEALING Summer School 2011 overall?



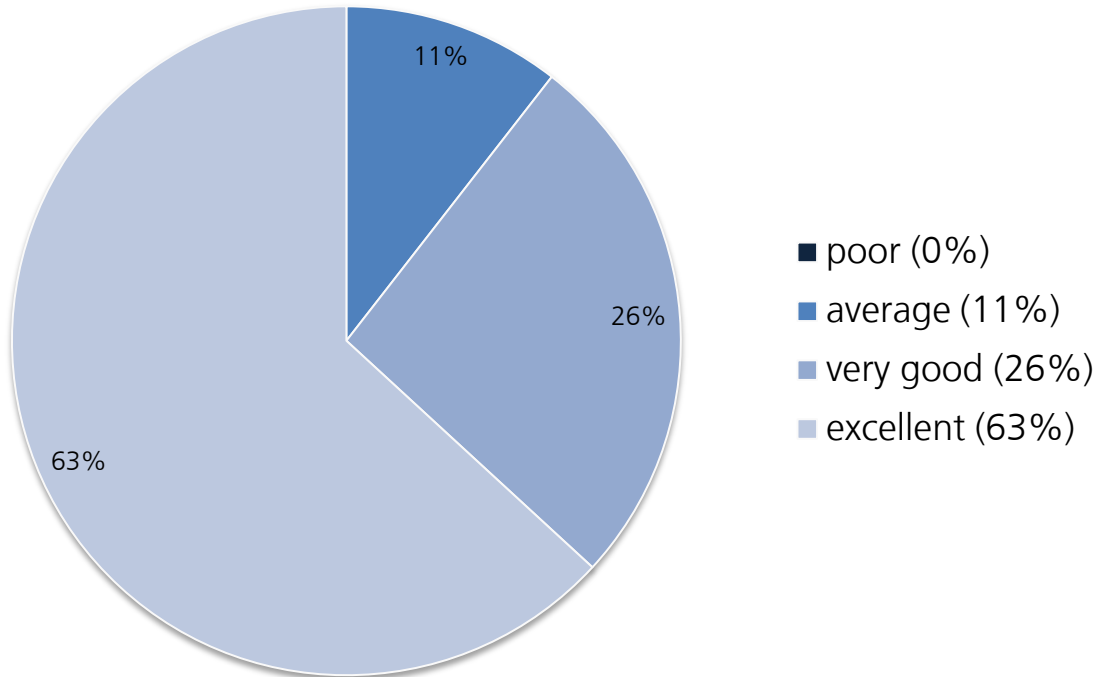


2. How relevant were the topics of this Summer School for your own research?
